The measurements to be taken for nutritional assessment includes; height, weight, fat fold thickness, circumferences like mid upper arm, waist, hip, head and chest. For example the International Society for the Advancement of Kinanthropometry accreditation system for anthropometrists has operated since 1996 with the aim of establishing a global standard for anthropometry. Over 3,000 anthropometrists from 49 countries have been accredited in anthropometric measurement techniques under this scheme . Adoption of these criteria allows standardisation of measurements between participants and of repeated measurements on the same participants.

Objective anthropometric measurements included length/height, weight and body circumferences, performed according to standard procedures. Body mass index (BMI) was classified according to the World Health Organization (WHO) growth charts for children and adolescents, and WHO criteria for adults.
